Included on the library shelves is a fairly large quantity of obsolete VHS format video tapes. Take as many as you want- VHS tapes unclaimed by September 30, 2018 will be removed from the library and donated to the Good Will.

This offer does not apply to DVD movies. Removal of the VHS tapes from the library shelves will free up space for more DVDs and books for lake members to borrow and enjoy.

As always, the library welcomes your donations of books and DVDs. The library now features property labels to be affixed to items as you donate them. Labeling donated items will help remind borrowers to return them to the library after they have read or viewed them.
