Columbia and Clatsop County Soil and Water Conservation Districts are partnering together to obtain grant funds to cover the cost of manual removal and herbicidal treatment of garlic mustard, yellow archangel, and yellow flag iris that have been observed in common areas and on private lots at FLRC. In order to qualify for grant funds, we are required to have volunteers who are committed to assisting the Riparian Specialists when they are on site.

If you know or suspect that you have any of these invasive species on your lot, your participation is encouraged, as your involvement will allow the Riparian Specialists to gain access to your lot. Even if you don't have invasive species on your particular lot, your participation is welcome and needed.

If you are willing to participate in this important project to help FLRC obtain a grant award, please complete the information below and return this form to the office by email, US mail, or by dropping it in the lock box at the office. The deadline for submitting the grant is December 14th, so **we must receive your completed form by December 7th** to allow the Riparian Specialists to substantiate our willingness to complete this project.

The work will take place in 2019 and updates will be provided as they are received from Columbia and Clatsop County Soil and Water Conservation Districts. There is potential for grant funds to cover some of the cost of native plants that will replace the invasive species that are removed.
